Stout players drafted by NFL or AFL players

1. 1967, KC Chiefs drafted Dick Erickson, Center in the 7th Round (out of 17 rounds). He was #183 out of 445 drafted. That's pretty impressive actually. Dick never made the team and didn't play in the NFL or AFL. Two notable drafted AFTER him were Ken Houston (9th Round, #214) who played 14 years and was a HOFer. Preston Pearson was a DB drafted #298 in the 12th Round.
2. 1970, NY Giants drafted Gary Inskeep, Tackle (13th Round of 17). He was taken #325 of 442. He never played in the NFL either, but went on to play in the Canadian Football League. Two notables behind him were Doug Sutherland (Viking DE for 12 years taken #348) and Mark Moseley, K taken #346.
3. 1971, MIN drafted Reggie Holmes, DB (12th Round of 17). He was taken #310 of 442. He never played in the NFL. One notable taken after him was Jeff Wright, also a DB taken by MIN in the 15th Round at #388. He spent 7 years with the Vikings.
