Expand early and ongoing experiential learning opportunities including undergraduate applied research and entrepreneurship

Description:

- Definition of experiential learning:
 - Experiential education refers to a pedagogical philosophy and methodology concerned with learning activities outside of the traditional classroom environment, with objectives which are planned and articulated prior to the experience.
- Promote involvement in professional organizations early in major
- Institutionalize undergraduate research, creative activities, and entrepreneurship across all disciplines.
- Require progressive applied experiences throughout their academic careers at UW-Stout culminating in capstone experience
- Encourage global experiential learning
