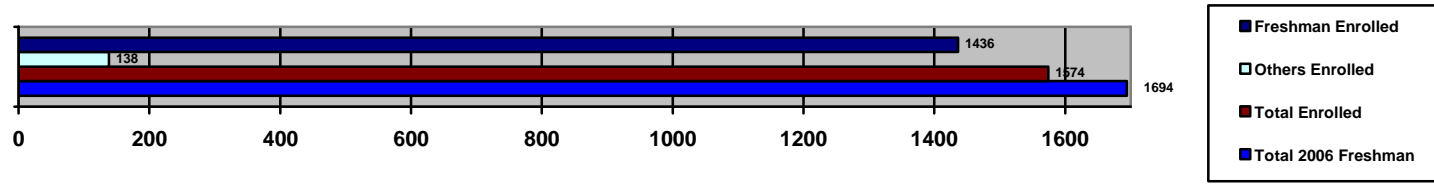


### Task 1.1.3 Executive Summary

As described in last year's report, the original Task 1.1.3 was integrated into other tasks. As an extension of this activity a new on-line academic skills curriculum was developed to assist new students, especially freshmen; and a total of 1,574 students were "enrolled" (given access) to this supplemental instruction, and of these, 1,436 (91%) were freshman.



### Strengths of the Activity

- 85% of all new freshman enrolled
- Of those who viewed one or more topics
  - Over all students the average number of topics viewed was 3.37
  - For female participants the average number of topics viewed was 3.15
  - For male participants the average number of topics viewed was 3.72
  - For freshman participants the average number of topics viewed was 3.34
  - For sophomore participants the average number of topics viewed was 4.00

### Opportunities to Improve the Activity

- Expand use by students

### Action Plan to Improve the Activity

- Develop strategies to encourage increased student usage
- Develop strategies to increase awareness of the resource across other stakeholders, such as faculty and program directors
