## Goals of FYE for 2006-07

- 1. Improve retention for select populations of Year 1(Fall 06) to Year 2(Fall 07) students. (Example populations: Learning Community participants, MathTLC participants, Career Exploration Course participants, Writing TLC participants, Career Cluster participants)
  - a. Current Rate: 73%b. Fall 07 Target: 75%c. 2010 Target: 80%
- 2. Decrease student departures related to:
  - a. Academic dismissal- 10% of "first time, fulltime" cohort
  - b. Student self identified as planning to depart after semester 1 or 2 but stay -- 60% of cohort -students who self identify not planning to return Y2
  - c. Develop Exit interview tool, implementation process—Administer Exit Interview commencing Fall 2007
- 3. Improve student satisfaction in the first year. Targets are associated with specific tools and results-see chart
- 4. Increase faculty/staff involvement in FYE programming.
  - a. Learning Communities Target: 3 Learning Communities in 2006-07; 5Learning Communities in 2007-08
  - b. Early Alert program Target: 60% participation of all instructors teaching first year students
  - c. Into the Book Target: Maintain current participation
- 5. Reduce student participation in at risk behaviors related to alcohol.
  - a. Discipline Records target: Joan
